## CERVICAL SCREENING LUCY'S BLOG



This week is my turn to write our blog.

With 2022 coming to a close, I thought it may be helpful to give an overview of some of the work we have delivered this year and why this project continues to be so important.

Five thousand deaths a year are prevented by Cervical Screening (www.england.nhs.uk). We want to ensure every patient in Suffolk can access Cervical Screening and the team are here to support with any reasonable adjustment you may need.y

One question I am often asked is; do I need to attend Cervical Screening even though I am not sexually active? Human Papillomavirus [HPV] can cause abnormal cell changes which could lead to Cervical Cancer. HPV is passed by skin-to skin contact. If a person has never had any form of sexual contact the chances of getting HPV are lowered. But a low risk is never NO risk. We encourage all patients with a cervix to attend Cervical Screening. Please contact one of our Nurse Health Educators via our social media or direct from our website if you would like to find out more.

Over the last 12 months Suffolk GP Federation's "Very Important Invitation" Cervical Screening Project has worked hard to improve the uptake of cervical screening throughout Suffolk.

The project has worked closely with the Integrated Care Board, Health Partners, GP Surgeries, Community organisations, and patients in delivering education programmes to enable an increase in Cervical Screening uptake across the county.

## How has the team delivered this:

- We work closely with Public Health, the Integrated Care Board and GP Surgeries to identify women and people with a cervix who may need additional support attending Cervical Screening.
- Our team consists of myself as Project Manager as well as four Nurse Health Educators who are registered nurses and are qualified to carry out Cervical Screening. The Nurse Health Educators work closely with GP Surgeries across East and West Suffolk. Admin Assistant Ashleigh is often behind the scenes organising our diaries, social media, online Cervical Screening booking requests, and keeping our website up to date.
- We run targeted publicity campaigns across Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, TikTok and LinkedIn as well as radio coverage, podcasts and now our weekly blog. As well as this we have been attending community and commercial events, and co-producing with healthcare partners, social care partners and charities on awareness campaigns to support attendance of Cervical Screening.
- Suffolk GP Federation's GP+ extended access service continues to offer screening appointments on weekday evenings and during the day on Saturdays. GP+ operates across 9 sites across East and West Suffolk.
